This 1-day TRAQ renewal review class and exam is open to current TRAQ credential holders **only**. The TRAQ Renewal Course is a one-day event, with five hours of review instruction, and three hours to take the indoor and outdoor exam. Current TRAQ holders can complete this abbreviated course as early as 12 months prior to your qualification expiration date, or up to 6 months past your expiration date with an approved extension. Once you have successfully passed the requirements, your credential will be extended 5 years from the date of your previous expiration. This allows you to take full advantage of the 5 year period granted with the credential.

This renewal course and exam is **limited to 30 TRAQ credential holders** (first-come/first-served). It is required that you attend the course and successfully complete the exams in order to renew your qualification.

REGISTRATION CLOSING AT MIDNIGHT ON Monday, September 11, 2017 (EST) OR WHEN CLASS IS FILLED

- If paying by check, we must receive your check by **September 11, 2017** to remain on the class list.
- Cancellation/refund/substitution requests must be submitted by **September 11, 2017**.
- All applications will be reviewed - your registration will be confirmed via email from Florida ISA.
- Prior to the class ISA will ship your TRAQ RENEWAL welcome packet from Champaign, IL via UPS to the address you provide (**NO PO BOXES**). The packet will include a copy of the *Tree Risk Assessment Manual*; the *Tree Risk Assessment Workbook* will be handed out at the class. No discount or refund will be given if you already own a manual.
- If you need to apply for a TRAQ exam RETAKE only, you must contact ISA at QUAL@ISA-Arbor.com or call 1-217-355-9411. Individuals taking a re-take exam will not receive a new manual or workbook.

WHAT TO BRING TO THE CLASS

- Your government issued photo ID
- Tree Risk Assessment Manual (shipped to you to the address you provide - no PO boxes)
- Tree Risk Assessment Workbook will be handed out to you at the class.
- Hard hat and high visibility vest or shirt (required)
- #2 pencils and clipboard for taking notes and completing worksheets
- Rain gear, including a large ziplock bag (just in case!)

To renew your Tree Risk Assessment Qualification (TRAQ) you must currently hold the TRAQ credential and be approaching your expiration/renewal date. Current TRAQ holders may take the renewal course as early as 12 months prior to your expiration date, or up to 6 months past your expiration date with an approved extension. Once passing the renewal exam, your expiration date will be updated for 5 additional years from your original expiration date.
